Born: Ajka, Hungary 1977-

She started her studies at the High School of Arts and Crafts in Budapest at the Book Design Department. With her book objects she won the Lajos Lengyel prize and she was invited to the book object exhibition of the Hungarian Institute in Berlin in 1998. She graduated in 2000 at the Moholy-Nagy University of Art and Design Budapest, at the Graphic Design Department, receiving her MA (Master of Arts) there. Her master was József Baska, a Hungarian painter from Slovakia. After graduation she won an Italian state scholarship to Rome to the Accademia di Belle Arti, doing etching there. Between 2001 and 2012 she lived and worked in Athens, Greece, where in 2004 she won the first prize of Comic Art Greece. She has participated on several international exhibitions and art festivals, among others at the Biennale of Thessaloniki. In 2005 she won a scholarship to the Center of Graphic Arts in Kasterlee, Belgium, where she exhibited her works. In 2012 she has moved back to Budapest. She has participated at the Hungarian Graphic Biennale of Békéscsaba in 2017 and at the Budapest Illustration Festival in 2021. She mainly deals with drawing and graphic art, but occasionally she makes 3D works. In 2014 and in 2020 with her installations she was shortlisted for the exhibition of the Hungarian Pavilion of the Venice Art Biennale. Her first public sculpture, the bronze memorial of Nákó-Wallenberg was made in 2021 in the Castle of Buda commemorating the Greek Nákó family who cooperated with Raoul Wallenberg to save children during the 2nd World War in Budapest. The last four years she has been working at the Media Institute of the Moholy-Nagy University of Art and Design Budapest, organizing international art projects with the students. Her research field is the survival of the line drawing in the digital environment.
